



2022 Lighting Technicians' Pay Increase

The below sets out the agreement reached between Pact and BECTU as approved by a ballot of lighting technicians:

- As of 1st April 2022, additional grades have been added to the agreement and the rates have been set for rigging and shooting grades as outlined in Appendix A ('Rate Increases') on all feature films intended for initial cinematic exhibition or a single piece of theatric-type content (i.e. not a series) intended for a global SVOD platform with a budget equal to or above £30 million ('Major Motion Picture').
- The Rate Increases will apply retrospectively and is implemented on all new productions, and on all productions that commenced before 1st April 2022.
- The Rate Increases will apply for 3 (three) years starting from the 1st April 2022 until the 31st March 2025 (inclusive).
- At the end of year 2 (31st March 2024), the Rate Increases will be reviewed against inflation statistics so that the rates for year 3 (1st April 2024 to 31 March 2025) can be assessed in accordance with inflation.
- The rates for Desk Ops will continue to increase beyond the 3-year period of this agreement so that the rates for shooting and rigging Desk Ops will be the same by year 5.
- Producers acknowledge that Heads of Department, Gaffers and Best Boys negotiate their rates and other terms at the outset of a production as per the Major Motion Picture Agreement.
- Pact and BECTU have also agreed to have an on-going dialogue over trainees' roles and their rates.
